Highlights of Performance Comparison Between MPS and Other Urban School Districts

4th Grade Knowledge and Concepts Tests: Reading and Math

Beloit

 White students' performance in reading and in math was similar* in Beloit and MPS districts.

Green Bay

- Green Bay's economically disadvantaged students performance in reading was similar to* that of MPS' disadvantaged students.
- When the percentages of students not tested and testing at minimal performance are combined, the performance of Green Bay students in <u>every minority category was lower</u> than that of their MPS counterparts in reading and math.
- At the two highest levels of performance combined (proficient and advanced performance), Green Bay's Native American and Asian American students performed similar to* or less well than their MPS counterparts.

Madison

- Madison failed to test its economically disadvantaged students at <u>twice the rate</u> of MPS.
- When the percentages of students not tested and testing at minimal performance are combined, Madison's economically disadvantaged students' performance is similar to* that of MPS students in both reading and math.

This information is based on the tables that follow. This summary and the tables that follow were produced by the Center for Education Research, Analysis, and Innovation (CERAI) at the University of Wisconsin--Milwaukee.

* The phrase "similar to" means that the district's performance in this category was within 3% of MPS' performance. E.g., if 30% of MPS' Black students scored in the proficient or advanced levels on reading, and 32% of Kenosha's Black students did, MPS and Kenosha's performance could be said to be "similar to" each other.
